How much is Eskom electricity per kWh in South Africa?

As we noted earlier, the Eskom unit price per kWh is not fixed because of different Blocks of electricity consumers in South Africa. However, the Eskom rates per kWh in 2024 range from R2.00 to R23.00 per kWh. This means that the average unit price of Eskom electricity per kWh is around R2.50.

How much does electricity cost in South Africa?

Domestic Tariff: For those consuming more than 450 kWh but less than 600 kWh per month, the rate is R3.91 per kWh. **Home User Tariff:** This higher tariff applies to households with significant usage or higher property values, where the rate for consumption over 600 kWh can go up to R4.75 per kWh. **How Are Electricity Prices Determined in South Africa?**

How will Eskom's electricity price increase affect residential customers?

Some residential customers will experience a much higher increase than the 12.74% average electricity price increase, while others will see much lower increases. Some customers will even experience reductions in their monthly electricity spend. Eskom has three main suites of residential tariffs, namely Homelight, Homepower and Homeflex. Homelight

How much do utilities cost in South Africa?

According to Numbeo, utilities in South Africa cost around R1,700 per month. Utilities mostly account for electricity and water. Most electricity comes from Eskom, which has several tariffs. As an example of water costs, in Cape Town, you'll pay around R433 for 10,500 liters, including sanitation.

How much does Eskom charge per kWh in 2024?

The Eskom rates per kWh in 2024 is not fixed, it varies from R2.00 to R3.00. However, electricity consumers in Block 1 are more likely to pay lower rates than those in other blocks.
