How much solar power does Iraq have?

According to the International Renewable Energy Agency, Iraq has an installed PV capacity of only 216 MW despite a huge solar potential. No additional solar power has been deployed in the country in the past three years.

How much does electricity cost in Iraq?

As of March 2024, the average cost of electricity from utility companies in Iraq (including power, distribution and transmission costs as well as taxes) is \$0.015 per kWh for residential consumers and \$0.046 per kWh for businesses. 3

How much sun does Iraq get a year?

Iraq (Baghdad) receives an average of 3,250 hours of sunshine per year. The sunniest month is August with approximately 353 hours of sunshine, while January records the least at about 192 hours. 1
