How much does electricity cost in Estonia?

Estonia, June 2023: The price of electricity is 0.320 U.S. Dollar per kWh for households and 0.183 U.S. Dollar for businesses which includes all components of the electricity bill such as the cost of power, distribution and taxes.

How much energy does Estonia use?

Estonia's all-time peak consumption is 1591 MW (in 2021). In 2021 the electricity generated from renewable energy sources was 29.3 %, being 38% of the share of renewable energy in gross final energy consumption. Oil-based fuels, including oil shale and fuel oils, accounted for about 80% of domestic production in 2016.

How much PV capacity does Estonia have?

According to Andres Meesak, CEO of Estonia's PV association, Estonia now has around 107 MW of cumulative installed PV capacity. This represents a significant increase from the 17 MW of cumulative capacity at the end of 2017.

What data does Statistics Estonia collect?

To produce energy statistics, Statistics Estonia collects the following data: stocks of energy products, imports and exports. In Estonia, a large share of energy is still produced from non-renewable resources such as oil shale.

What is Eesti Energia's Energy Plan?

'We are honoured to contribute to Eesti Energia's energy plan for desynchronisation (disconnecting from Russia's grid) in the Baltic countries,' said Kyuwon Heo, Head of Grid ESS Europe at LG Energy Solution. Estonia is targeting an exit from electricity production from shale gas and a 40% renewable energy mix by 2030.

Is Eesti Energia launching pumped hydro energy storage projects?

Eesti Energia and a consortium of private companies are also launching separate, large-scale pumped hydro energy storage (PHES) projects, though these would come online in the late 2020s.
