Are bean seeds easy to save?

Bean seeds are among the easiest types of seeds to save, especially dry bean seeds. One bean plant produces enough seeds to repopulate a whole garden row the following year. Seed saving allows you to continue to select the plants that thrive in your garden conditions for the characteristics you want.

How do you store bean seeds?

When storing seeds, place in a tightly sealed glass jar or other container. Different varieties of beans may be stored together but wrapped in individual paper packages and clearly labeled with their name, variety, and collection date. Your bean seeds should stay cool and dry, around 32 to 41 degrees F. (0-5 C.).

Can You propagate green bean seeds?

With minimal effort, you can propagate your own green bean seeds for generations. Keep reading to learn how! Green bean pods form early in the season, but you must leave some on the vines longer to allow the seeds inside to fully mature. Follow these tips for ideal harvest timing:

How do you save bush bean seeds?

Saving bush bean seeds is even easier than saving pole bean seeds! Best of all, this time you won't need the ladder! Inspect bush bean plants for viable seed pods. Toward the end of the season, look for oversized bean pods or those that are nearly dry. Harvest bean seeds one pod at a time.
