

How will Canada's housing market change in 2026?

Canada's housing market experienced a correction in 2024 and 2025, but prices are expected to stabilize with slight gains of 1% to 2% in 2026. For migrants, this presents a window of opportunity to plan future home ownership. Tips for newcomers: Begin renting, then explore homeownership after 12-18 months. Use first-time buyer incentives.

Balanced supply-demand conditions in the Prairies, Quebec, and parts of Atlantic Canada are expected to support modest price gains in 2025 and 2026. In contrast, Ontario and B.C. will continue to face challenges with imbalances in condo markets in Toronto and Vancouver likely spilling into other segments.

Is Canada facing a rental housing shortage?

Rent Trends: Challenges Ahead Canada faces a rental housing shortage expected to worsen by 2026, with a projected deficit of over 120,000 purpose-built rental units. According to RBC Economics, limited new housing supply and growing immigration are likely to drive higher rent growth in urban centers.
