



Seiko solar watch battery v158

Which Seiko watches have a v158 caliber?

The Seiko caliber V158 is found in some Seiko solar-powered watches, including the exclusive Street Series Solar Divers. This caliber is part of the Seiko Watch Corporation V family/series of solar powered movements. The movement in your timepiece may actually be signed with the caliber number V158A.

How accurate is a Seiko v158?

Seiko claims that the caliber V158 will maintain accuracy of +/- 15 seconds per month at normal operating temperatures of about 5C to 35C (41F - 140F). The caliber V158 is a solar powered watch with a manganese titanium-lithium rechargeable capacitor. It is not a normal battery. The number is MT920, or more specifically: 302324Y. What does v158a mean on a Seiko Watch?

This caliber is part of the Seiko Watch Corporation V family/series of solar powered movements. The movement in your timepiece may actually be signed with the caliber number V158A. As with all Seiko movements, the trailing letter indicates the evolution or change-log of the movement, starting with A as the first release.

What type of battery does a Seiko solar watch use?

Seiko solar watches typically use a rechargeable lithium-ion battery.
